Primary Responsibilities

- Help instructors set up and prepare any necessary tools and materials before class
- Help instructors clean up and organize equipment after class
- Greet and assist students with sign-in
- Ensure students are using tools safely and responsibly
- Work with students one-on-one to ensure that they're following instruction and completing class tasks
- Assist instructors with other duties as needed

- Can learn quickly and adjust to an ever-changing work environment
- Great interpersonal and teamwork skills
- Experience and/or desire to work with people from diverse backgrounds
